PARTICIPATION CONTRACT

Dear Parents, Guardians, and Students: Please read the following and sign the attached contract to indicate you understand and agree with the following:

BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS

- I will honor my commitment to Starlight Studios and the Starlighters Theater Company
- I understand that mature behavior, positive attitude and teamwork are mandatory during rehearsal and shows. I will be respectful to all the adults and fellow cast members. I will make every effort to compliment and support my fellow cast and backstage members.
- I will make the commitment to prepare and memorize **BEFORE** rehearsals.
- Starlight Studios rules apply while at rehearsal locations and I must remain in locations as directed by the staff and parents of Starlight Studios and always ask an adult for permission to go somewhere else in the building.
- If my behavior is such that is disruptive, and not seen as in the best interest of Starlight Studios and the Starlighters Theater Company, I may be asked to leave the group.
- I will talk to the directors or coordinators if something is happening that is keeping me from having an enjoyable, rewarding theater experience.

REHEARSALS AND ATTENDANCE

- I will do my best to make it to every rehearsal or meeting where I am needed. I have checked for any conflicts with scheduling before signing the contract. If I have more than 3 conflicts, I understand that it might keep me from getting lead roles. If I have more than 5 conflicts, it may be necessary to re-evaluate my priorities.
- I understand that extended or additional rehearsal on Saturdays and tech week may be necessary and I am willing to adjust my schedule to make it to those rehearsals.
- I am responsible for making transportation arrangements ahead of time.
- I understand that extra bodies make extra noise, therefore I will not bring my friends to rehearsal.
- It is my responsibility to notify the administrator of Starlight Studios and the Starlighters Theater Company if I am unable to attend a regularly scheduled rehearsal or meeting due to sickness or another emergency.

PARENT/GUARDIAN VOLUNTEER EXPECTATIONS: IMPORTANT!

- I will check the rehearsal or meeting schedule and will be on time to pick up my child after rehearsals. I understand that the volunteers cannot leave until my child is picked up.
- I understand that the Starlighters Theater Company operates through the efforts of parent volunteers.
- I understand that parents are expected to coordinate or help with a production committee or by volunteering at several regular rehearsals or meetings. Commitment will be about 20+ hours before, during, and after the production. Set pieces will need to be returned to the theaters and we'll need help with large pieces therefore; dads or very strong boys are required to help out 2-5 hours during move in or strike.
- I understand that all parents are also expected to volunteer with at least ONE tech/dress rehearsal and/or performances.
- **WITHDRAWING FROM A PRODUCTION AND REFUNDS:** If you withdraw from a production for any reason after the cast list is posted, no refund is given. If you withdraw from a production, you will not be allowed to audition for the next production you are eligible for unless excused by the producers or artistic directors for extenuating circumstances. It is the performer's responsibility to inform Starlight Studios of your circumstance within one week of withdrawing from a production in order to be cleared for the next audition.
